It was a small group of concerned citizens who took action in 1974 that led to the birth of Women In Distress (WID). With the support of sponsors and donors like you, we have grown into the largest domestic violence shelter in the state of Florida.

In addition to being an emergency shelter, WID's wrap-around services include a 24-Hour Crisis Hotline, counseling therapy for adults and children, economic empowerment services, a pet shelter community and youth educational programming, professional trainings on domestic violence, and other critical, life-saving services.

A young girl and her grandmother were walking down the beach. It was a beautiful afternoon and the tide had pulled back leaving hundreds of starfish stranded on the sand.

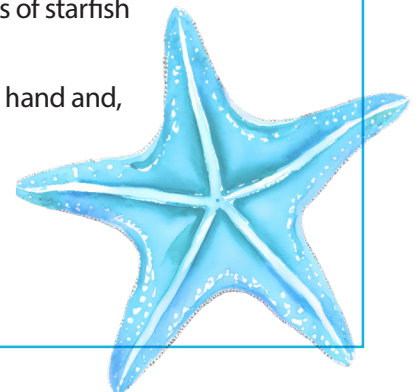
The girl began picking up starfish and throwing them back into the sea.
